Peck not only talked about all that the city has accomplished but emphasized the infrastructure improvements peeded to accompany emphasized the infrastructure improvements needed to accommodate new growth. 5. Fill in bald spots

Steps to get your

Autumn is also a great time of year to fix any bare, bald spots in your lawn. The quickest, easiest way to do this is with an all-in-one lawn-repair mixture. Sold at most garden shops and home centers, this ready-to-use mixture contains grass seed, a special quick-starter lawn fertilizer and organic mulch.

Use a garden rake to scratch loose the soil at the bald spot in your lawn. Then spread a thick layer of the lawn repair mixture over the area. Lightly compact the mixture, then water thoroughly, and continue to water every other day for two weeks.

6. Control the weeds

If broadleaf weeds such as dandelions have taken over your lawn, now's the time to fight back. Weeds, like most plants, are in the energy-absorbing mode during the fall. They're drinking in everything that comes their way, including weed-killers. Apply an herbicide now, and the weeds

won't return in the spring.
Read the package label before use. Most herbicide manufacturers recommend applying the weed-killer in early to mid autumn, when daytime temperatures are consistently above 60 degrees.
