





PMI

If your down payment was less than 20 percent of the purchase price, you will be required to buy Private Mortgage Insurance. The insurance protects the lender against you defaulting on the loan. Once you have sufficient equity in the house, the PMI coverage can be canceled

HOMEOWNERS INSURANCE

You can't get a loan without taking out homeowner's insurance but that doesn't cover everything, especially if you live in an area where natural disasters occur. You should consider supplemental policies for floods, tornados, hurricanes and earthquakes.
