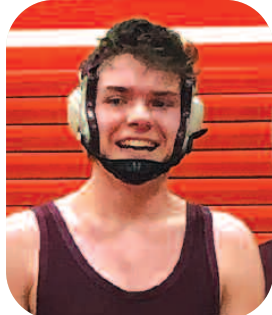

Run away victories against Trojans, Lancers

EAST JORDAN — For the third straight contest, the East Jordan girls basketball team put their opponent away early.

On December 10, the Lady Red Devils defeated Ellsworth 57-5, and had the game in control 25-1 after the horn sounded to end the opening quarter.

The Red Devils, winners of their season opener a few nights earlier, jumped out early on the young Trojans team, taking a 10-0 lead after one quarter of play and were in full control 22-5 at the half.

# Boyerne earns W, gets back on track

### Boyerne City 67, Cedarville 55

CEDARVILLE — Back in the win column. After a week of playing top notch opponents and dropping two straight, the Boyerne City boys basketball team got things going their way, as they traveled across the bridge and came back with their third victory of the season as they defeated Cedarville 67-55 on December 10. The Ramblers took a one-point halftime lead and turned it into a 51-39 advantage after the third quarter, behind some long distance shooting, as the team connected on four triples during the eight minute span. "Great to get a win on the road against a tough Cedarville team," Rambler coach Nick Redman said. "Proud of how we responded in the second half. We really played together tonight. I'm proud of our guys." It would be sophomore Aiden Brehm would connect on a pair of triples in the third, scoring six of his 15 points, while Max Vondra and Dillon Sulak each knocked down a shot from beyond the arch as the Ramblers started to pull away in the quarter. Brehm and Sulak each scored 15 points to lead the team, while Vondra added nine points and

Pete Calcaterra finished with eight points. Coach Redman also credited Calcaterra with great second half defense on the Trojans Jarron Masuga.

### McBain 67, Boyerne City 48

MCBAIN — After a pair of early season victories, the Boyerne City boys basketball team has not had as much success in their latest contests. The Boyerne City offense has not been as crisp as it was in the first week of the season, falling to McBain 67-48 on December 6. "McBain played well," Boyerne coach Nick Redman said. "Their team was mentally ready to play and we weren't. I need to do a better job and that's on me." McBain started fast, taking an 18-8 lead at the end of one quarter and continued that in the second as they took a 34-22 cushion into the half. Boyerne was unable to get things going in the third, falling further behind. Aiden Brehm and Max Vondra each finished with eight points to lead Boyerne City, while Pete Calcaterra and Harry Moody both chipped in with six points.

# Ellsworth picks up first W, Fall late to Trojans

### Ellsworth 71 Wolverine 42

WOLVERINE — The Ellsworth Lancers finally were able to pick up their first victory of the season on December 5, after coming up just short in a number of close contests to start the season. The Lancers jumped out early on the Wildcats, rolling to a 18-8 first quarter lead and expanded that margin to 37-19 at the half, before taking a 51-31 advantage into the final eight minutes of regulation. "Good to get a win, never know what is going to happen in Wolverine," Ellsworth coach Jarod Steenwyk said. "Started out a little slow, but picked up the pressure that lead to open layups in transition. Everyone contributed and got quality minutes." Atlas Marlatt finished with 24 points, six rebounds and six steals to lead Ellsworth, while Lucas Sweet added 11 points, four assists and three rebounds. Ethan Tornga collected 10 points and 10 boards, and Richard Adams and Michael Clees each made four steals.

### Central Lake 58 Ellsworth 56

CENTRAL LAKE — Down to the wire. The Ellsworth basketball team faced a familiar foe on December 3, when they traveled to Central Lake. Lucas Sweet stepped up for the second game in a row with some big shoots." It would be some late foul trouble that would hurt the Lancers after they carried a 43-37 lead into the fourth quarter. The Lancers were able to maintain the lead for the entire fourth quarter, but the Trojans were able to pull closer at the charity stripe with no time ticking away, setting up the shot from Spangler. Atlas Marlatt had 14 points and six rebounds for Ellsworth, while Ethan Tornga scored 13 and hauled in 20 boards and Lucas Sweet chipped in with 12 points.

## CHOOSING A FORECLOSED HOME TO BUY

Foreclosed homes represent some of the finest buying opportunities in many years. If one understands how to choose the right property, they can be pleased with the purchase.

Just because it is a foreclosed property, does not automatically guarantee that it will be a good buy. There are several factors to consider before choosing a property and making an offer. This will help ensure that a choice will be the right one.

**Purpose**  
Is one an investor or looking for a home to live in? Depending on the intended use for the property, the buying criteria may be somewhat different. Investors usually are planning to either rent the property or resell it. The primary consideration is positive cash flow, or the ability to profit from a resale.

Owner-occupant buyers who intend to buy a foreclosed home to live in are not concerned about rental cash flow. Their priorities are correlated to the size of the home and the location. They too should be very mindful of other criteria that will have a big impact on the purchase after it is completed.

**Location**  
If an investor, the most common mistake is location. The property choice should be influenced by an investment plan. If intending to rent the property, choose a home that does not have too much competition in the immediate area.

One of the things that led to a high foreclosure rate among investors during the last years of the housing boom was investors who bought properties for rental, in areas where there were already many vacant rentals on

the market. It will force rent rates down, or vacancy rate will be higher. If planning to resell, the same rule applies. A property may look very cheap, but if there is too much competition for rental or resale, it is going to reduce cash flow or force to lower the selling price.

Owner-occupants need to choose locations occupied by more owner-occupants than there are tenants. Buying a home to live in, in an area with lots of rental properties, will likely cause the home value to remain lower. Preferably, stay in an area that is made up of a high majority of owner-occupants. This will help ensure that the property value will remain stable or go up, not down.

**Afford**  
Investors want positive cash flow. Owner-occupants need affordable payments. Investors should know before buying, what the rental rate or resale value would be. Then determine an offer price that insures costs will not exceed the likely cash flow or resale value.

Owner-occupants should qualify themselves based on their take-home pay not gross income. For a mortgage that is comfortable and affordable, try not to exceed 36% of take home pay for a monthly payment. One may qualify for more, but this could lead to financial problems down the road. Have a monthly payment firmly in mind when shopping and making offers. Do not let agents or lenders tempt to borrow more than you can afford. Buying a foreclosed home in a good location, with a monthly payment that is affordable will result in less stress and more happiness in a new home.
