# Ramblers finish strong in victory over Blazers

## BOYNE CITY 69, KALKASKA 66

BOYNE CITY — This time, the Ramblers stepped up their game when they needed.

Boyne City outlasted the visiting Blazers during the final eight minutes of play, outscoring Kalkaska 22-16 in the final frame to turn a three point deficit into a three point win, 69-66 on December 18, picking up a tough Lake Michigan Conference win in the process and improving to 4-2 overall, 1-0 league.

“Great to get a league win against a good team tonight,” Boyne City coach Nick Redman said. “Outstanding team effort, really happy with how the team responded after Kalkaska went on runs.”

The Ramblers led 16-14 after one quarter of play, before the Blazers used a late second quarter run to pull ahead 33-32 at intermission and Kalkaska entered the fourth quarter up 50-47.

During the BC fourth quarter comeback, senior Dillon Sulak connected on a pair of triples and sophomore Aiden Brehm hit one three and a pair of late tosses from the charity stripe to help seal the victory.

A lot of guys stepped up and made plays when we needed it,” coach Redman added. “Great win headed

into the Christmas break.”

Brehm led the Ramblers with 15 points, while Sulak had 13 and Pete Calcaterra added nine and six rebounds.

John Paul Moody chipped in five boards and Trevor King had eight points and four rebounds.

GRAYLING — They all can't come easy.

The East Jordan girls basketball team found that out when they traveled to Grayling on December 18.

Following a tough battle with the host Vikings, the Red Devils returned home with a thrilling 37-36 Lake Michigan Conference victory and in the process, improved to 6-0 on the season.

EJ led 8-5 after the first quarter, but fell behind 19-13 at the half and 26-20 entering the fourth quarter.

"We struggled in almost every facet of the game tonight, except maybe at the defensive end. We shot 20 percent from the floor and played rather sloppy at the offensive end. Jayden (Weber) kept us in the game as she was 10-for-11 from the free throw line while going 8-for-8 in the fourth quarter."

With about a minute to go East Jordan found themselves down three and Grayling had the ball. The Red Devils forced a turnover and drew a foul, Jayden Weber strolled to the line with about 30 seconds left and connected on both free throws to close the gap to one point.

EJ then had to foul, sending the Vikings to the charity stripe, where they hit the first of two shots, and after an EJ rebound, Hines called timeout with about 20 seconds remaining in the contest trailing by two.

Following the timeout, the Red Devils inbounded the ball, passed it to the wing and then back to Kitson near the top of the key and she let the triple try fly with about three seconds to go and hit nothing but net as the horn sounded.

"We led the first quarter and never led again until the

## Fishing tourney info to include muskie, walleye

Starting Jan. 1, all bass and walleye fishing tournaments, as well as competitive fishing events targeting muskellunge, must be registered in the DNR's Michigan Fishing Tournament Information System, available online. These events must report their results, too.

The inclusion of walleye and muskie adds to the statewide registration and reporting requirements for bass fishing tournaments that have been in place since 2016. Tournament and event directors are required to register and report using the

Fishing Tournament Information System. The DNR has worked the last 10 months to overhaul the system in order to accommodate the new requirements. That system now is operational and currently accepting 2019 registrations.

"This is an important step in gaining a better understanding of what competitive walleye and muskellunge fishing means to angling, conservation and Michigan's economy," said Tom Goneia, a fisheries biologist and the DNR's tournament fishing specialist. "To date, the Fishing Tournament Infor-

mation System has been a tremendous success, receiving more than 2,000 bass tournament registrations and reports. We expect a smooth transition to include a couple hundred annual walleye and muskellunge events."

## Wayne County resident charged in bull elk poaching

VANDERBILT – A 60-year-old Taylor resident has been charged with the illegal killing of a bull elk, after an investigation by Michigan Department of Natural Resources conservation officers and police in Otsego County.

The incident occurred Saturday, south of Vanderbilt.

The name of the man is not being released pending his arraignment in Otsego County District Court. The charge is a misdemeanor punishable by up to 180 days in jail and a fine of \$2,000.

In addition, mandatory penalties include \$5,000 restitution for the animal, more for an antlered elk, and hunting privileges being revoked for 15 years on a first offense. At about 9:50 a.m. Saturday, Otsego

County dispatchers received a tip about the elk poaching. The information was forwarded to conservation officers operating the DNR's Report All Poaching line (800-292-7800).

A Michigan State Police trooper and an Otsego County Sheriff's deputy were able to locate the carcass of the elk, the crossbow used to kill the animal and the suspect.

"Without the public's help, this case might not have been solved," said Sgt. Mark DePew of the DNR. "The information we received led to a positive outcome in this investigation."

Meanwhile, conservation officers are continuing their investigation into a November elk poaching case in Montmorency County. In that incident, two bull elk car-

cases were discovered on Saturday, Nov. 17, off Montmorency County Road 622, near Roth Road.

The location is situated about 7 miles north of Atlanta, just south of Clear Lake State Park. The animals appeared to have been shot Thursday, Nov. 15, the opening day of the firearm deer hunting season.

Anyone with information regarding the November elk poaching should call the DNR Gaylord Customer Service Center at 989-732-3541 or the 24-hour DNR Report All Poaching line at 800-292-7800. Information can be left anonymously; monetary rewards may be offered for information that leads to the arrest of violators.

### ORDINANCE NO. 245

An Ordinance to Amend Part II, Code of Ordinances of the City of East Jordan, by adding new Chapter 33, Marihuana

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF EAST JORDAN HEREBY ORDAINS:

Chapter 33 of Part II of the Code of Ordinances for the City of East Jordan is hereby added, to read as follows:

#### Chapter 33 PROHIBITION OF MARIHUANA FACILITIES AND USE

##### Section 1 Purpose and Prohibition:

**Purpose.** The purpose of this Chapter is to exercise the City of East Jordan's authority to prohibit the establishment or operation of marihuana establishments within the City as such facilities are defined in the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act (the "Act").

**Prohibition.** Pursuant to the Act, the City prohibits the establishment or operation of any and all categories of marihuana establishments within its boundaries.

##### Section 2:

No person shall consume (including smoking) cultivate, distribute, process, sell, or display marihuana or marihuana accessories in a building owned or operated by the City of East Jordan.

No person shall consume (including smoking) marihuana in a public place within the boundaries of the City of East Jordan, including but not limited to any street, sidewalk, highway, alley, park, or parking lot located therein, or the City docks, City beaches or Tourist Park Campground area.

##### Section 3 Severability:

The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable, and if any clause, sentence, word, section or provision is declared void or unenforceable for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining portions of said ordinance shall remain in force.

##### Section 4 Violation of Ordinance

A person or other legal entity violating this ordinance is responsible for a municipal civil infraction as defined by Michigan law and is subject to a civil fine of not more than \$500.00, plus costs, which may include all direct or indirect expenses to which the City of East Jordan has incurred with regard to the violation. A violator of this division shall also be subject to such additional sanctions, remedies, and judicial order as are authorized under Michigan law. Each day a violation of this division continues to exist constitutes a separate violation.

##### Section 5 Effective Date:

This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its adoption and publication.

large E-2 plan -- this is one of several floor plans available in a specific building

listing -- an agreement between a real estate broker and a home owner that allows the broker to market and arrange for the sale of the owner's home. The word "listing" is also used to refer to the for-sale home itself. A home being sold by the owner without a real estate agent isn't a "listing."

lo dues -- low homeowner's association dues. But find out how "low" the dues are compared to other dues in the area.

lock box -- locked key-holding device affixed to a for-sale home so real estate professionals can gain entry into the home after obtaining permission from the listing agent

lsd pkg. -- leased parking area. May come with additional cost.

MLS -- Multiple Listing

Service. An MLS is an organization that collects, compiles and distributes information about homes listed for sale by its members, who are real estate brokers. Membership isn't open to the general public, although selected MLS data may be sold to real estate listings Web sites. MLSs are local or regional. There is no MLS covering the whole country.
