The Ramblers improved to 12-0-1 overall, 8-0-1 in the Lake Michigan Conference, following an impressive 5-0 victory over Elk Rapids on May 6.

Boyne got on the scoreboard just eight minutes into the game when sophomore Inanna Hauger was credited with a goal after a corner kick bounced off the post and connected with Hauger's head and ricocheted into the back of the net for a 1-0 Rambler lead.

Taylor Noble made it 2-0 with 2:28 remaining in the half.

Following the intermission, Jordan Noble was able to move in for a score at the 35:26 mark for a 3-0 BC advantage. Hauger then took a pass from Taylor Noble just over two minutes later and scored for a 4-0 lead.

Taylor Noble finished the scoring with 18 seconds to play, for the 5-0 final.

Cora Hauger earned the win in goal, facing just 12 shots in recording the Ramblers 10 shutout of the season and sixth in a row.

#### Ordinance No. 1 of 2019

AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE AN ENFORCING AGENCY TO DISCHARGE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF MARION TOWNSHIP, CHARLEVOIX COUNTY, MICHIGAN AND TO DESIGNATE REGULATED FLOOD HAZARD AREAS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE ACT, ACT NO. 230 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1972, AS AMENDED.

THE TOWNSHIP OF MARION, CHARLEVOIX COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

#### Section 1. Agency Designated.

Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Charlevoix County Building Official is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of Marion Township, Charlevoix County, Michigan under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended. Charlevoix County has assumed responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout the corporate limits of Marion Township.

#### Section 2. Code Appendix Enforcement.

Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code shall be enforced by the Charlevoix County Building Official throughout the corporate limits of Marion Township, Charlevoix County, Michigan.

#### Section 3. Designation of Regulated Flood Prone Hazard Areas.

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Study (FIS) Entitled "The Flood Insurance Study for Charlevoix County, All Jurisdictions" and dated May 16, 2019 and the Flood Insurance Rate Map(s) (FIRMS) panel number(s) of 26093CINDOA, 2Q093CO281D, 26093CO282D, 26093CO284D, 26093CO294D, 26093CO301D, 26093CO302D, 26093CO303D, 26093CO304D, 26093CO306D, 26093CO308D, 26093CO311D, 26093CO315D, and 26093CO320D and dated May 16, 2019 are hereby adopted-by reference for the purposes of administration of the Michigan Construction Code, and are hereby declared to be a part of Section 1612.3 of the Michigan Building Code and to provide the content of the "Flood Hazards" section of Table R301.2(1) of the Michigan Residential Code.

#### Section 4. Repeals.

All ordinances inconsistent with the, provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

#### Section 5. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall become effective May 11, 2019. (The day after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation within the Township).

### MARION TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE PROHIBITING MARIJUANA ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP

#### Ordinance No. 2 of 2019

AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO THE MICHIGAN REGULATION AND TAXATION OF MARIJUANA ACT, 2018 INITIATED LAW 1, § 6.1, MCL 333.27956, SUBSECTION 1, TO PROHIBIT MARIJUANA ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF MARION TOWNSHIP AND TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

MARION TOWNSHIP HEREBY ORDAINS:

#### Section 1. Marihuana Establishments Prohibited.

Pursuant to the authority granted under Section 6.1 of the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act, 2018 Initiated Law 1, § 6.1, MCL 333.27956, Subsection 1, Marion Township hereby completely prohibits any marihuana establishment, as that term is defined in Section 3(h) of the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act, 2018 Initiated Law 1, § 3(h), MCL 333.27953(h), within its boundaries.

#### Section 2. Violation; Penalty.

Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be responsible for a municipal civil infraction as defined in Public Act 12 of 1994, amending Public Act 236 of 1961, being Sections 600.101-600.9939 of Michigan Compiled Laws, and shall be subject to a fine of not more than Five Hundred and 00/100 (\$500.00) Dollars. Each day this Ordinance is violated shall be considered as a separate violation.

#### Section 3. Enforcement Officials.

The Township Supervisor and any other person appointed by the Township Board are hereby designated as the authorized officials to issue municipal civil infraction citations directing alleged violators of this Ordinance to appear in court.

#### Section 4. Nuisance Per Se.

A violation of this Ordinance is hereby declared to be a nuisance per se and is declared to be offensive to the public health, safety and welfare.

#### Section 5. Separate Court Action.

In addition to enforcing this Ordinance through the use of a municipal civil infraction proceeding, the Township may initiate proceedings in the Circuit Court to abate or eliminate the nuisance per se or any other violation of this Ordinance.

#### Section 6. Validity.

If any section, provision or clause of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not effect any remaining portions or application of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid portion or application.

#### Section 7. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after being published in a newspaper of general circulation within the Township.
