Red Devils shock Ramblers, Rayders in LMC play

EAST JORDAN 51, CHARLEVOIX 50 OT

CHARLEVOIX — Taking a huge step forward.

That is exactly what the East Jordan boys basketball team did on Friday, January 18 when they defeated Charlevoix 51-50 in overtime of their Lake Michigan Conference clash.

That huge step came after the Red Devils took their first big step earlier in the week when they defeated Boyne City.

AJ Bartlett connected on what would be the game winner with 7.9 seconds remaining in overtime, fresh off his game-tying bucket with 1.9 to play in regulation to finish with 11 points on the night and propel East Jordan to their second LMC win of the week.

East Jordan led 10-4 after the first quarter and were up 21-16 at halftime. Charlevoix would take a 31-27 lead into the fourth.

"A great atmosphere for high school basketball, both student sections were loud and energetic and the gym was full," East Jordan coach Nate Dzwik said. "We had talked about continuing to play with confidence believing we can win and playing a full 32 minutes, I was glad the kids played a full 36 in this

Coach Dzwik noted that the first quarter was a defensive grind, with the Rayders taking the first possession of the game for over a minute long and his Red Devils did a good job not letting them get a great look before EJ corralled the rebound, which he believed "really set the tone for the night."

Charlevoix would take leads of five and six points late in regulation, but East Jordan battled on defense contesting shots and grabbing the boards. Jackson Raymond would take over for the Red Devils as time ticked

away, turning the corner a few times off screens and isolation plays to create opportunities for EJ, assisting on both the play to tie the game and then the play to win the game in OT.

"We really did a good job of executing on both ends of the floor when we needed to at the end as far as getting pressure, fouling when needed to and rebounding on defense," Dzwik added. "On offense we did a good job of being patient and moving the ball and finding the openings."

"Coach Stuck does a great job of getting the team into a good play and Evan Solomon

and Jacob Mueller are really good. Evan was a constant problem for us as we had to get into help and try to recover out of it and Jacob did a great job of getting rebounds and finding gaps. We felt we had a good match up with him as Jackson Raymond has some length and height and Jackson did a good job to hold him to 10 points."

Raymond would finish with 17 points, five assists and four blocks to lead EJ, while Cooper Stevenson chipped in with 12 points and two blocks for EJ.

Solomon finished with 19

points to pace the Rayders. "The kids are playing with a ton of energy and believe in what we are trying to do right now. There is a lot of confidence right now," coach Dzwik added.

EAST JORDAN 57, BOYNE CITY 54

EAST JORDAN — Execution down the stretch was the key for the East Jordan boys basketball team on January 15, as they clipped rival Boyne City 57-54 in a Lake Michigan Conference contest.

With the game tied at 51-51 with about one minute remaining, East Jordan's Cooper Stevenson made a steal at the top of the key, was fouled and converted from the charity stripe, before the Red Devil defense clamped down forcing Boyne City into a couple of shots. Jackson Raymond would corral the rebounds and knock down the tosses from the free throw line.

Boyne would have another opportunity as coach Redman drew up a play for Max Vondra that the team and the junior ran to perfection to pull the Ramblers to within three. Following a timeout, the Red Devils would inbound the ball to Raymond and the point guard would float a pass over the top of the defense to an open Joe Atwood who was able to get away from his defender and run out the clock.

"Great game that was back and forth and within six points the whole night," East Jordan coach Nate Dzwik said. "The kids came out with a lot of energy and effort, we did a really good job of keeping Boyne out of the paint when the used dribble drive. The team did a really nice job of everytime Boyne would go on a run of six points that we would settle in and answer with a run of our own."

The Red Devils led at the quarter breaks, 9-8, 27-24 and 40-36.

"Hats off to Nate (Dzwik) and team (Red Devils), Boyne City coach Nick Redman said. "They executed well and you could see they really wanted it."

Max Vondra scored 15 and Pete Calcaterra finished with 10 to lead BC, while Aiden Brehm had eight and Jacob Steinhoff added six.

"We need to keep improving our continuous effort, focus, execution and free throw shooting," Redman added.

Raymond would finish with 23 points, on 9-of-14

Red Devils drop pair of tough LMC contests

CHARLEVOIX 48, EAST JORDAN 39

CHARLEVOIX — The Rayders used a 9-0 run to begin the second half, turning a one point halftime lead into a 10 point advantage, as Charlevoix defeated East Jordan 48-39 on January 18 in Lake Michigan Conference girls basketball action.

The Red Devils would use a tough defensive effort against the Rayders, limiting all-stater, Elise Stuck to only seven points, but Addie Nagel stepped up with 14 and Taylor Petroskey added 13 to lead Charlevoix to the victory.

East Jordan led 8-5 after the first quarter, but Charlevoix gained a 21-20 advantage at the break, before taking a 37-28 lead into the fourth.

"We played a good game tonight except for the 2 1/2 minutes at the start of the third quarter," Red Devils coach Steve Hines said. "We were down one at halftime and Charlevoix had a run and we went down ten and played even from that point on. A ten point deficit is hard to come back from, especially on a good team. We did a good job keeping Elise (Stuck) in check, we took better care of the ball and we rebounded well, especially at the defensive end."

Jayden Weber paced EJ with 12 points, while Lauren Peterson and Tia Spence chipped in with six each.

Weber also added 13 rebounds and Madeline Malpass had seven. Molly Kitson finished with six assists.

"Charlevoix was able to knock down six three pointers and that was that biggest difference," Hines noted. "We played with great intensity tonight and look forward to

maintaining that intensity and getting back on the winning track this next week." EJ slips to 8-3 overall, and 2-3 in league play, while the Rayders improve to 6-2, 5-0.

Ramblers edge Red Devils

BOYNE CITY 40, EAST JORDAN 37

BOYNE CITY — Another strong outing from Josee Behling is just what the Boyne City girls basketball team needed.

The Rambler junior finished with 19 points and 16 boards to lead Boyne to a 40-37 Lake Michigan Conference win over East Jordan on January 15.

The Ramblers led 10-9, 18-15 and 26-22 at the quarter breaks.

"Close game most of the way with Boyne City leading after each of the quarter breaks," EJ coach Steve Hines said. "We found ourselves down by seven points late in the fourth quarter and made a great comeback to tie the game with about a minute left."

Molly Kitson would connect on a pair of three pointers to tie the game inside the final minute, but a pair of Rambler free throws would give BC the lead back and an EJ turnover would all but seal the deal for Boyne.

"I thought we came out a little flat tonight and just didn't have the intensity needed against a good ball club," coach Hines added. "Josee Behling really played well tonight and was probably the

difference. We just gave up too many easy baskets!"

In addition to Behling, Reagan May added eight points,

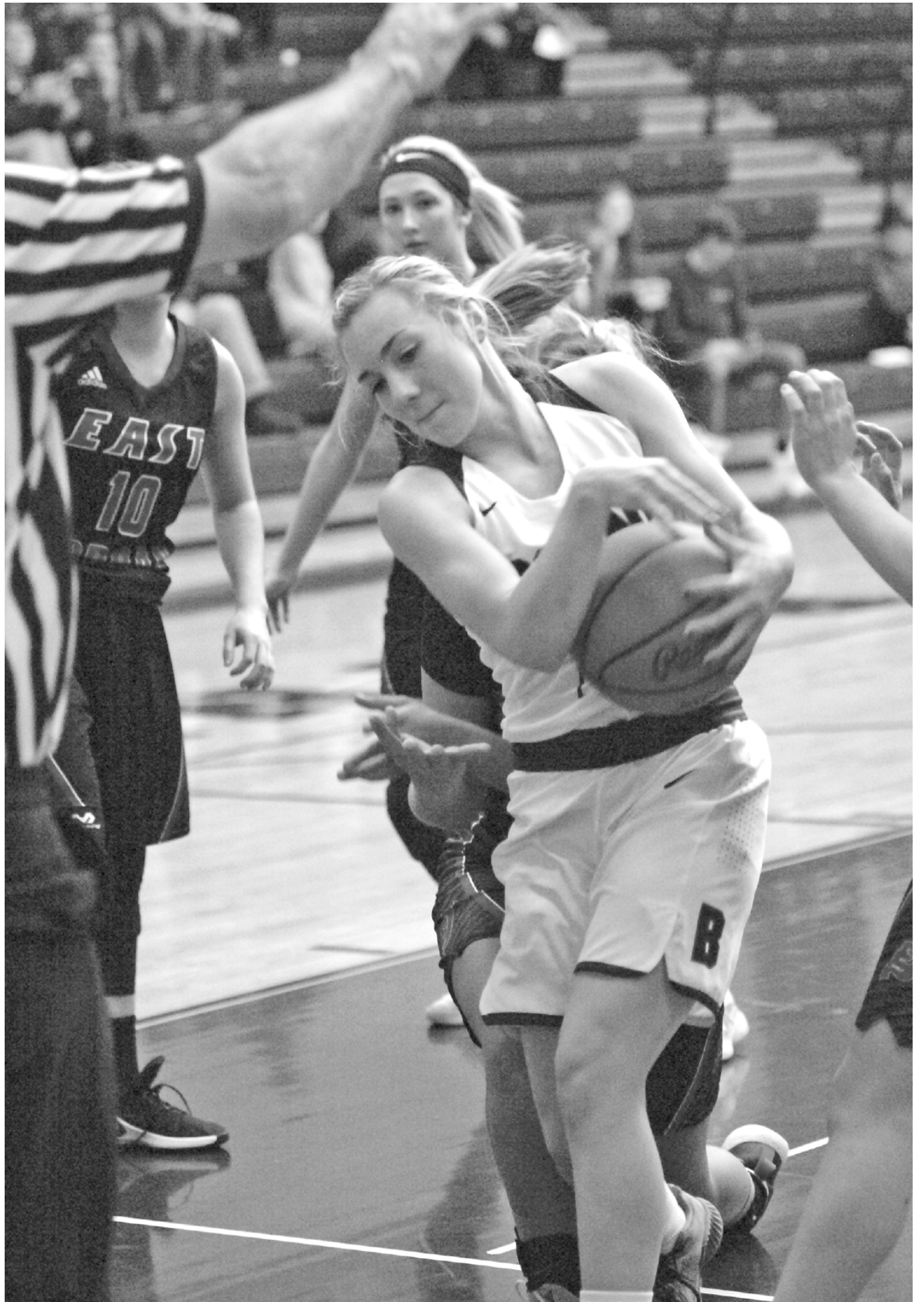
while Brooklyn Fitzpatrick had 10 rebounds.

DNR FISHING NEWS

Finding panfish through the ice

Have you been attempting to target panfish during your ice fishing trips this winter, but aren't having much luck? Consider the following things. Are the panfish sticking to

shallow or deep depths? Are they hanging out in the weeds or on the rocks? Are they suspended or are they hugging the bottom? Due to the weather much of the state has experienced re-

cently, panfish are likely to be in deeper water to find more oxygen. Keep that in mind when you look for them! Also keep your presentation efforts in mind. A popular effort in-

cludes putting a jig on the bottom and using a twitch-pause-twitch routine with it. For more information on winter fishing in Michigan, visit Michigan.gov/fishing.

DNR to seek feedback from ice anglers

This winter fishing season, DNR creel clerks again will be out and about at many fishing spots to interview anglers about the details of their trips. Most interviews take just a few minutes, but the critical information gathered makes a big difference to successful fisheries management. "Anglers' is just another word for the people who fish, and 'creel clerks' is a term for the people who talk to anglers about their fishing trips," said Tracy Claramunt, a fisheries biologist who runs the DNR's Statewide Angler Survey Program, a long-term monitoring program that tracks recreational fisheries across

Michigan waters of the Great Lakes and select inland waters. Claramunt said that the word creel comes from the name for an old-fashioned basket that fishermen used to keep their catch in, and creel clerks were the folks who'd stop and ask the fishermen what they caught. Today's survey model works much the same way. DNR creel clerks ask anglers, through brief interviews, about how long they fished, what species they targeted, what they caught and where they live. Statewide, clerks talk fishing with roughly 80,000 people a year. Sometimes the clerks might ask to measure or weigh fish and

take scale samples to gather key biological information on those fish. These data help fisheries managers make decisions about fishing regulations, habitat improvement and fish-stocking needs. This winter creel clerks plan to talk with anglers fishing Saginaw Bay, Lake St. Clair, the Les Cheneaux Islands, Munising, Marquette, Keweenaw Bay, Lac Vieux Desert, Otsego Lake and Little Bay de Noc. Starting April 1 and continuing into the fall, creel clerks will interview anglers at Great Lakes boating access sites, fishing piers and shorelines across the entire coastline to get

estimates on spring, summer and fall fisheries. Claramunt said most people are happy to talk about their time on the water. "Everyone loves to tell their fish tales," she said. "And we appreciate anglers' willingness to share their experiences with us. Every detail gives us valuable information about Michigan's fish populations and health."
