# Ramblers record 25 hits in sweep of Red Devils

EAST JORDAN — When the Boyne City offense is clicking, they do it well.

The Ramblers spread out 25 hits over two games as they defeated East Jordan 12-2 and 14-3 in a Lake Michigan Conference sweep on

In the opener, it didn't take long for Boyne to get on the scoreboard, as sophomore Magee Behling took the second pitch of the game and sent it over the left-center wall, the Ramblers would score three in the opening inning.

Boyne would tack on five more in the third and three more in the fourth, highlighted by a Katelyn Gabos home run.

The Red Devils scored twice in the third.

Madeline Malpass had two hits, including a triple for EJ, while Jaden McCoy added a single.

McCoy took the pitching loss for the Red Devils, allowing 13 hits.

For the Ramblers, Gabos and Brooklyn Fitzpatrick had three hits each, with Gabos going yard and Fitzpatrick recording a triple. Behling added a single to her round tripper; Sophia Morias tripled and Leona Follette and Madison Rosenow both singled.

Rosenow earned the win in the circle with relief from Josee Behling as the two combined to strike out four.

In game two, the two teams each scored twice in the opening frame, before Boyne opened it up in the third with a seven run inning.

Zoe Harmon earned the pitching win, going the distance, allowing four hits and striking out eight.

Amber Gibson took the loss in three innings of work, allowing 10 hits and striking out one. Madeline Diller and McCoy pitched in relief.

At the plate for Boyne, Fitzpatrick had a double among four hits, Harmon doubled twice, Josee Behling had two hits and Follette doubled and singled.

"I was pleased with how we were making contact with the ball," Boyne coach Sandy Clausen said. "I am proud of the way we played, the spirit they had and we are starting to talk more in the field. We are making progress as a team."

"Even though we took a double loss tonight, I'm happy with how the girls played," EJ coach Meg Kitson said. "They did a real good job against a very potent offense."

# Boyne's Ethan Hills controls Red Devils in game 1, Ramblers hold on late in game 2

## BOYNE CITY 12-2, EAST JORDAN 0-1

EAST JORDAN — Lake Michigan Conference opponents know that if they are going to beat Boyne City, they will sooner or later have to face Rambler senior and Saginaw Valley State commit, Ethan Hills.

On April 25, the East Jordan Red Devils had that opportunity and while they were up for the challenge, so was Hills as the senior lefty struck out nine and did not allow a hit, en route to a 12-0 Boyne City game 1 victory.

Hills kept the Red Devils off balance all night, only allowing one base runner on a fourth inning hit batsman.

The Ramblers struck for one run in the first, added four in the third, tacked on six in the fourth and the final run an inning later.

Chandler Bartig took the loss for EJ, tossing 3 innings of ball, allowing 11 runs on 10 hits, striking out four and walking seven.

Cooper Stevenson went 1 innings of relief, giving up one run on one hit, striking out two and walking a pair.

At the plate for Boyne,

Nick Aown had a three-run homer to go with a single, while Corben Wilhelm and Hills added two hits each and Devon Hayden, Aaron Bess, Alex McGeorge, Stephen Orban and Bobby Hoth all had one hit, with McGeorges a double.

In the nightcap, the Ramblers put a two spot on the board in the top of the second and made it hold up as EJ battled back to score on in the bottom of the sixth when the Red Devils first two batters reached base off of McGeorge, before Justin Barnett drilled a base hit off Hills, who entered the game in relief, plating Bartig, making it 2-1 BC.

East Jordan then moved the tying run to third and the winning run to second with no outs before Hills struck out the heart of the Red Devil lineup 4,5, and 6 hitters to secure the win for Boyne.

AJ Bartlett finished with two singles to lead EJ, while Bartig, Sawyer Thomas, Adam Skrocki, and Barnett all added one hit.

Barnett went the distance on the hill for the Red Devils, allowing two runs on seven hits, striking out two and walking a pair.

"Barnett pitched a fantastic game for us," EJ coach Tom Reid said. "He was very efficient and he and our catcher, Gus Scheier, did a fantastic job keeping Boyne's

For Boyne, Aown started, worked four innings, allowing two hits, fanned five and walked one, before leaving.

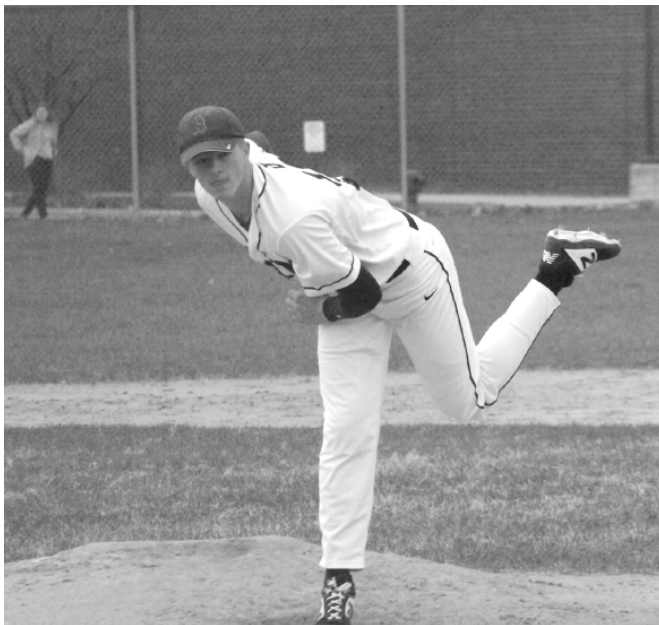
McGeorge worked the fifth inning, allowing one run on three hits.
