The wind made it tough and we had some drops and missed some plays, but their line was the difference."

Jackson Raymond had himself a break through game offensively, hauling in seven receptions for 167 yards, including a 46-yard touchdown.

Levi Pepin recorded the other EJ score, via a 22-yard reception. Both touchdowns came from backup quarterback, Dawson Olstrom, as he stepped in and threw for 242 yards after senior starter, Chandler Bartig had to leave the game with a slight injury. Defensively, Cooper

Stevenson led the way again

with 17 tackles, while Zander Johnecheck added 12 and Keenan O'Neill had chipped in with nine.

Raymond forced a fumble and Olstrom had a fumble recovery.

"We have to fix some things in our protection, fire off in the ground game and protect the ball and we are going to be fine," coach Kitson added. "This is a great group of kids that never give up. We knew the start of the season was going to be tough. We have been in two of our three games. We just need to focus on getting better every day and we will turn this around."





Seelye finished with five kills, 18 assists, six digs and an ace, while Gabos added five kills, 11 digs and was 15of-16 on serve receive.



earned a win, defeating the Rams 25-10, 25-7 and 15-8.






Calcaterra and Max Mathews each made six tackles and Tacorey Newman made three tackles and added two sacks.






