EAST JORDAN -- They were close before, but it all came together on Friday night, September 27, in front of a packed house as the Red Devils defeated visiting Inland Lakes 55-10 at EJ's Homecoming

East Jordan got things going early as Chandler Bartig connected with Jackson Raymond on a 41-yard pass for a 8-0 lead as they found each other again for the conversion.

Minutes later, Red Devils running back, Judd Wise broke free for a 31-yard run and Cooper Stevenson plunged in for a 1-yard score and the EJ defense recorded a safety for a 22-0 lead following the first 12 minutes of play.

The Bulldogs got things going with a field goal early in the second, before the Red Devil connection of Bartig and Raymond connected again for another touchdown, this time from 17-yards out.

Stevenson added a 40-yard run, Bartig then scooted 30-yards for a score with Colby Ferguson kicking the extra point (43-10) to close the first half.

In the third, EJ's Jordan Elmer get his first TD of the year with a

2-yard run and Aidan Webb got in the action with a 6 yard touchdown to complete the scoring.

Pepin had an outstanding game on offense with 141 yards on 11 carries, while Stevenson also added 101 on five carries and two scores.

"I have to give the credit to our offensive line tonight," Red Devil coach Greg Kitson said. "With the rain we didn't want to have to throw. Caleb Boyer, Keenan O'Neill, David LaButte, Nolan Roehrig, and Colby Ferguson really were awesome tonight. We had over 350 yards rushing and we were not sacked all night. Those guys were our MVP tonight."

On the defensive side of the ball, Stevenson finished with eight tackles. Wyatt Thompson and Caleb Boyer both had seven, and Pepin forced a fumble that was covered by Bartig.

"I am very proud of these guys, homecoming is always a challenge because of the distractions all week," coach Kitson added. "This year we had a number of players on the court so we miss them for part of halftime too. These guys stayed on task all week and it all came together tonight. We were able to get many players involved and rest some others and any time you can do that at this point of the season it is a bonus."

In a tight contest, that saw Charlevoix and Frankfort knotted at 8-8 at intermission, the Rayder halftime adjustments, not only helped slow down the Panther offensive attack, holding them to just eight points, while Charlevoix made plenty of offensive adjustments as well, exploding for 29 second half points.

With the victory, the Rayders improve to 4-1 overall, including 2-0 in the North-

ern Michigan Football League - Leaders Division.

Charlevoix struck first in the contest, as quarterback, Cole Wright connected with receiver Jacob Mueller on a 14-yard scoring strike and following a successful conversion attempt, it was 8-0 Rayders. It wouldn't take long though for the Panthers to respond as they knotted the game at 8-8, a score that would carry the teams into the half.

In the second half, the Rayders would once again strike first as Alan Ritter turned on the jets as he broke free, pulling away from would be defenders for

a 74-yard TD run. The conversion attempt was unsuccessful, putting Charlevoix up 14-8.

Frankfort would not take long to respond, scoring a touchdown and after a successful conversion attempt, it was 15-14 Panthers. That would be the last time they would hold the lead as it was all Maroon and White from there on.

Wright started the final scoring spree with a 60-yard run in the third, followed by a 29-yard scamper early on in the fourth. Jake Snyder got into the action as well, racing 70-vards minutes later.

Wright would finish his night with 106 yards on 15 rushing attempts and a pair of TDs, while Jake Snyder matched that rushing total and scores on just 10 carries, and Ritter added a score and 74 vards rushing.

Dimitrii Bell led the defense with 15 stops and an interception, while Luke Snyder wrapped up 11, Ritter had 10 tackles and Jake Snyder finished with nine and an interception. Wright and Wyatt Putman also added picks.



It's not always necessary to shampoo the carpets, but that's a nice touch. This also means wipe down cabinets, inside and out. It doesn't hurt to make your last impression on the

buyer a good one by polishing sink fixtures. Leave your home the way you, as a buyer, would like to find it.

#3: TURN OFF SHUT-OFF VALVES

If you have disconnected a washer, for example, make sure the shut-off value is completely turned off because a small drip, drip, can eventually flood a home. Some sellers shut off the valves to all water sources such as sinks, toilets and dishwashers, too. Leave a note for the buyers so they won't call a plumber when the water won't turn on.

#4: ATTEND THE FINAL WALK-THROUGH

There are so many quirks that only a home seller knows, and you could pass on these tips to a new home buver during the final walkthrough. Things like which light switch operates the lights, whether a door sticks, or how to clean a swimming pool. I like to ask sellers what they always wanted to do for a home improvement project but never got around to doing.

#5: CANCEL YOUR INSUR-ANCE POLICIES

Wait until you know the deed has recorded or title transfer has formally occurred before you call your insurance agent. You should receive a refund from a prepaid premium for your homeowner's insur-


