CHARLEVOIX — An opening drive by the Charlevoix on their first possession would be the highlight of the evening for the Rayders as Joburg scored 22 straight unanswered to pull out a 22-6 non-conference victory on October 4 in front of a packed homecoming crowd at Kipke Field.

The Rayders got on the board in the first quarter, using a long opening drive, capped by a 27-yard scoring pass from Cole Wright to Jake Snyder for a 6-0 advantage, which turned out to be the first and last time Charlevoix would move the scoreboard.

Each team was unable to get much offense going for the remainder of the half, but credit both defensive teams, highlighted by a Charlevoix goal line stand late in the second quarter, halting the Cardinals.

Following the intermission, the Cardinals came out with some adjustments, and they moved quickly, taking a 7-6 lead early in the third.

Joburg would score again twice in the fourth for the final scoring of the night.

Wright paced the Rayder offense with 70 yards passing on 7-15 and a score. Luke Snyder led the defense with 20 stops.




Rayder senior, Alex Kwapisz was crowned homecoming king, while Abby Paramo, was named queen. (photo by Scott Richards)





CHARLEVOIX — On October 2, Boyne City traveled to Charlevoix to face the Lake Michigan Conference Rayders in a match that was dedicated to the late Shelly Pamaro, mother of Charlevoix senior Abby Paramo.

The Rayders sported blue uniforms with "Shelly Strong" printed on them.

In the opening match, the two teams took turns taking control before Charlevoix capitalized with some strong play down the stretch for a 26-24 win.

In the second set, the Ramblers responded with solid play of their own, coming away with a 25-14 victory.

Boyne would also edge the Rayders in each of the next two sets, 25-23 and 25-22 for the win.

"Just a few plays would have made the difference for us, but our Rival match with Boyne was strong and a nail biter match for our Rayder fans the whole way through," Charlevoix coach Audra Randall said. "It was exciting to see the girls step up as a team and probably have the most success as a team, they're many younger players on the team but they are really playing more together."

Abby Paramo finished with 14 kills, 28 digs and was 37-of-40 on serve receive for the Rayders, while Avery Zipp added 10 kills, 24 digs, 9-of-10 serve receive and three aces.

Zoe Brodin chipped in with 36 assists, five aces and six digs; Taylor Petrosky, 14 digs, 12-of-13 serve receive; Claire Scholten added three aces, 14 digs; Kirsten Wagner had 10 kills; Abby Cunningham four kills; Grace Lentz one ace, two kills and a block; and Olivia Vollmer added an ace, four digs and was perfect on serve receive.

"I was not surprised when Charlevoix came out with all the momentum in that first set, they were playing for something bigger than just a volleyball game," Boyne coach Mallory Slate said. "What I was extremely happy with is how my girls were able to swing the momentum in our favor for the rest of the night. Even though there

were times in sets three and four when I thought we were out of it, the girls made one great play and were able to get back in it."

"Josee Behling and Jillian Cain had amazing performances at the net, with equal greatness behind them in the backcourt with Katelyn Gabos," coach Slate added. "What also really helped us tonight was our serving, as a team we served at 99 percent, going 97 for 98 behind the line.

Annabelle Seelye paced Boyne with 18 assists, seven kills, 12 digs, a block and was 100 percent from the serve line. Brooklyn Fitzpatrick added nine kills, 13 digs, two aces, two blocks, 100 percent serving and was 20-for-24 on serve reception.

Katelyn Gabos had 25 digs, 20of-22 on serve receive, one ace and served perfect, Gabby Musser finished with seven kills, two aces, 100 percent serving; Jillian Cain added three kills, three blocks, two digs and served at 100 percent; Josee Behling, four kills, two blocks and Maggee Behling had 15 digs and was 12-for-14 on serve receive.



FOOTBALL Rambler comeback comes up short

BOYNE CITY — When the Ramblers and Gladiators meet, it usually comes down to the wire.

That would once again be the case on October 4, as Boyne City battled back late, only to come up short in falling to St. Francis 17-14 in a Northern Michigan Football League - Legends Division contest.

The game didn't start out as a hotly contested matchup, as Traverse Citv

took a 7-0 first quarter lead and pulled ahead 17-0 at the half, kicking a field goal as time ran down in the second quarter. The Ramblers could

muster little offense for the entire contest, but when they did, they covered a lot of ground.

Early in the fourth, senior quarterback, Pete Calcaterra connected with sophomore, Bobby Hoth for a 72-yard touchdown, and following a successful extra point by junior Ally Herrick, the Ramblers pulled to within two scores.

Minutes later, Calcaterra found senior Jakob Steinhoff from 22-yards out on a great leaping catch to pull within three after the Herrick extra point.

With the momentum completely in their favor, the Ramblers looked to come all the way back from the 17-0 hole they found themselves in, but the Gladiators were able to hold Boyne from moving the ball and escaped with the victory.

Calcaterra threw for 152 yards and touchdowns, but connected on only 5-of-18 passing.

Senior Nick Aown led the defense with 11 tackles, while Hoth and Jacob Gregware had 10 stops each, with both recording one for a loss. Senior, Max Vondra added eight tackles, includ-

ing three for a loss. With the loss, Boyne slips to 2-4 overall, 2-1 in league play.

HUNTING October offers options for upland game birds

Michigan is rich with opportunities to hunt a variety of upland game birds this month, with several seasons already open and other openers on the way.

Currently open are ruffed grouse and woodcock hunting. Ruffed grouse season runs through Nov. 14 and then reopens Dec. 1-Jan. 1, while woodcock season is open through Nov. 4.

Other key seasons include: Zone 1 (Upper Peninsula) pheasant hunting is open Oct. 10-31 in all of Menominee County and portions of Delta, Dickinson, Iron and Marquette counties.

Pheasant hunting in zones 2 and 3 (Lower Peninsula) runs Oct. 20-Nov. 14.

Sharp-tailed grouse hunting is open Oct. 10-31 in the eastern portions of Chippewa and Mackinac counties.

Upland game bird hunters will need a Michigan base license. Additionally, anyone hunting pheasant or sharptailed grouse will need a free pheasant/sharp-tailed grouse endorsement on their hunting license, except for those hunting pheasant only on hunting preserves. Woodcock hunters need a free woodcock stamp, which includes the federal HIP endorsement.

Base hunting licenses and free stamps and endorsements can be purchased online or

anywhere licenses are sold.


Offensively, Jackson Raymond had six receptions for

It's not always necessary to shampoo the carpets, but that's a nice touch. This also means wipe down cabinets, inside and out. It doesn't hurt to make your last impression on the buyer a good one by polishing sink fixtures. Leave your home the way you, as a buyer, would like to find it.

#3: TURN OFF SHUT-OFF VALVES

If you have disconnected a washer, for example, make sure the shut-off value is completely turned off because a small drip, drip, can eventually flood a home. Some sellers shut off the valves to all water sources such as sinks, toilets and dishwashers, too. Leave a note for the buyers so they won't call a plumber when the water won't turn on.

#4: ATTEND THE FINAL WALK-THROUGH



Things like which light switch operates the lights, whether a door sticks, or how to clean a swimming pool. I like to ask sellers what they always wanted to do for a home improvement project but never got around to doing.

#5: CANCEL YOUR INSUR-ANCE POLICIES

Wait until you know the deed has recorded or title transfer has formally occurred before you call your insurance agent. You should receive a refund from a prepaid premium for your homeowner's insurance.
