

## **DNR Fishing Tip** Ice fishing in the middle of the day

We often emphasize the best times to go ice fishing are early morning and around dusk - but what about those folks who can't go during those times and would prefer to fish in the middle of the day? Don't worry, there are options for you too!

A few species are ideal midday targets, including northern pike, yellow perch, bluegill, and rainbow and brown trout.

For northern pike you can set up tipups and enjoy a leisurely day on the ice. For yellow perch you can drill a high number of holes and move around frequently. For bluegill you can use a fish locator to follow around a school. And for rainbow and brown trout you can sightfish for them in shallower water.

# Three more poached elk near Vanderbilt

VANDERBILT - Michigan Department of Natural Resources conservation officers in Gaylord are seeking tips from the public regarding three adult cow elk poached in Otsego County - the third elk poaching case in northern Michigan in roughly a month.

"This is the worst year we've had as far as elk poaching," said Lt. Jim Gorno.

Area residents found the three elk about 50 yards north of Hardwood Lake Road near Bobcat Trail, in the Pigeon River State Forest, east of Vanderbilt. Officers believe that the three elk were shot either the Saturday or Sunday before Christmas while they were bedded down near each other.

"This is a loss for everyone who appreciates our state's natural resources. It's a true shame," said Gorno. "If you or anyone you know has information that can help us solve this crime, we want to hear

Gorno said that the public tips received regarding a bull elk poached in November helped identify a suspect in that case.

# What is the MLS?

MLS stands for "Multiple Listing Service," which is usually a computerized listing of virtually all the homes that are for sale in a specific area.

When a Realtor lists your property for sale, they pay a fee and your home is placed on the MLS system. The big advantage to sellers is that the MLS is the #1 resource used by buyers (and agents) to locate homes.

Properties that are not listed (usually those being sold by their owners) are not on the MLSthus there are many buyers and Realtors who will not be exposed to the home.

The MLS has become such a standard in real estate that no serious broker would think of trying to sell real estate without it. It would be like an accountant trying to work without a calculator.

About the only residential brokers who might not use the MLS are those who exclusively handle foreclosed properties, or high-end homes owned by celebrities and the like.

The MLS provides a surprising amount of detail, depending upon the area of the country it may include the location (by zip code); size of the home (square footage); size of the lot; number of bedrooms and bathrooms; extra rooms such as a den, family room, formal dining room, or enclosed patio; amenities such as a backyard, fireplace, hot tub, pool, kitchen features, new carpet and drapes; capacity of garage; age of home; and, of course, the sell-

ing price and terms.

Buyers can narrow their house-hunting searches dramatically by using the MLS. For instance, their real estate professional can do a computer search and ask for a listing of all homes within a certain location and price range that have two or three bedrooms and that are not more than ten years old. Not only will this request generate a brief list of viable possibilities, it also helps buyers gauge, roughly, what they can expect to get for their money, and to compare the value of the homes listed.

Thus, the MLS is more than a system that lists properties. It's an aid to both buyers and sellers, and is a definite asset to consumers when it comes to real estate.
