## MHSAA Suspends all athletic activities

The Michigan High School Athletic Association has directed all member schools to suspend activities in all sports for all seasons – effective Monday, March 16 through at least Sunday, April 5 – to fall in line with Gov. Gretchen Whitmer's order that all schools close for the next three weeks in order to deter the spread of

COVID-19.

All athletic activities to be halted include practices, scrimmages and competitions/games, as well as strength training, conditioning and any other organized sessions and activities in all MHSAA in-season and out-of-season sports.

The suspension of activities applies to sports for all three MHSAA seasons as Spring sports practices have begun, Winter tournaments

were suspended Thursday and Fall sports coaches are working with limited numbers of athletes during the off-season.

"By suspending all sports activities for the next three weeks, we are taking an additional step to maintain safety and minimize risk first, and also keep a level playing field for our schools and teams during this time of uncertainty," MHSAA Executive Director Mark Uyl

said. "A number of schools across the state already were making this decision, and setting this as the standard across our membership is appropriate especially given the quick pace with which this situation is continuing to evolve. Given the rapid, fast-moving and unprecedented events of this week, the MHSAA will use the time during this all-sport suspension of activities to evaluate all options and next steps

which will be shared with schools in a timely manner."

The MHSAA is a private, not-for-profit corporation of voluntary membership by more than 1,500 public and private senior high schools and junior high/middle schools which exists to develop common rules for athletic eligibility and

competition. No government funds or tax dollars support the MHSAA, which was the first such association nationally to not accept membership dues or tournament entry fees from schools. Member schools which enforce these rules are permitted to participate in MHSAA tournaments, which attract more than 1.4 million spectators each year.

CHEBOYGAN – It didn't take long for the Rayders to show that they are peaking at the right time as they dismantled Oscoda 65-29 to advance to the Division 3 regional finals for a fourth consecutive season.

Addie Nagel scored 22 and Elise Stuck added 18 to lead Charlevoix to the victory.

The Rayders wasted little time in setting the tone, hitting from both inside and outside as they built a 24-8 first quarter lead and expanded on that during the second, outscoring the Owls 19-10 to hold a 43-18 lead at half-time, capped by a Nagel triple at the buzzer, sending Charlevoix into the break with even more momentum and all but dashing any hope of a comeback for Oscoda.

Seemingly on cruise control in the second half, Charlevoix would earn a running clock as they outscored the Owls 22-11 in the final two quarters of play.

With the win, the Rayders (19-5) advance to the regional final against Ishpeming Westwood. The Patriots enter the contest at 22-2 and own a 47-29 victory over Charlevoix in last season's regional final.

# Ramblers survive upset minded Vikings 80-54

GRAYLING – Anything can happen when March Madness rolls around.

On March 11 in the Division 2 district semifinal, the Grayling Vikings tried their best, and for 16 minutes, they looked like they had a shot of knocking off defending district champ Boyne City.

After a strong start for the Ramblers, leading 23-17 at the close of the first quarter, the Vikings came out inspired and knocking down whatever shot they threw at the rim and were up 38-36 as the clock ticked down, but a Max Vondra triple as the half ended gave Boyne a 39-38 lead going into the break. In the second half, the Ramblers got continued to hit their own shots, while locking down defensively on Grayling to pull away with an 80-54 victory.

“We got off to a great start and then Grayling wanted it more than us heading into halftime,” Boyne coach Nick Redman said. “Proud of the guys for responding and playing tough in second half. Tonight again showed what the power of want can do, it’s March Madness, we are happy to get the win and earned right to keep playing.”

Senior Pete Calcaterra paced the Ramblers with 22 points and eight points, while junior Aiden Brehm added a double-double, dropping 15 points and grabbing 11 boards.

That duo got Boyne going in the third, both recording six points each in the quarter as the Ramblers outscored the Vikings 18-7 to create some breathing room, 57-45.

The fourth would see much of the same for both teams as Boyne City capitalized on a 23-9 scoring advantage to close out the contest and in the process, earned the right to play for another district title. It will be the 10th time in 11 seasons the Ramblers will be taking part in the championship game.

“We stepped up and played a great second half,” coach Redman added. “I’m proud of the team.”

BC seniors Stephen Orban scored 10 and Max Vondra added nine points, 10 rebounds and five assists, while freshman Jack Neer chipped in with eight, as 10 Ramblers got into the scoring column.

Boyne faces Kingsley in the championship game, after the Stags defeated Sault Ste. Marie 64-35 in the other semifinal. The Ramblers beat Kingsley earlier this season 55-42.
