

October is Breast Cancer Awareness month. According to the U.S. Breast Cancer Statistics:

"About 1 in 8 U.S. women (about 12.4%) will develop invasive breast cancer over the course of her lifetime. In 2018, an estimated 266, 120 new cases of invasive breast cancer are expected to be diagnosed in women in the U.S., along with 63, 960 new cases on NON invasive breast cancer."

Did you know that Breast Cancer is not just a woman's disease?

According to the American Cancer Society, "About 2,550 new cases of invasive breast cancer will be diagnosed in men and about 480 men will die from breast cancer."

This is just one of the manyreasons to be aware of and to take care of your health, especially as you age.

The Charlevoix County Commission on Aging wants our aging community to feelsupported in their health.

At our Senior Centers we provide nutritious meals andmenus that conform to the USDA Dietary Guidelinesfor Americans. We do thisfor our congregate meals (those eating in), take out meals and in our Home Delivered Meals. We also provide Free monthly blood pressure checks, and monthly Foot Clinics by appointment.

The COA Health Care Services also support a healthier lifestyle by providing In Home Health Services, Homemaker



Services, Personal Care Assistance, Respite and Foot Care (for the homebound). We also collaborate withthe Health Department of NWMI to provide Adult Immunization and Flu clinics; with the MSU Extension and Area Agency on Aging for nutrition and wellness programs.

Other collaborations are also with local organizations for classes based around nutrition and how it affects chronic illnesses like Diabetes, food safety, exercise classes and healthy food choice options throughout the year including Senior Project Fresh.

Join our Yoga, Tai Chi, Pickleball, Cardio Drumming and Adult Exercise Programs at the various Senior Centers; join our Walking clubs or walk the gyms at the Charlevoix and East Jordan Senior Centers. We also have Wii bowling to get you up and moving and will be hosting Bingocize this year too. Check with our Site Coordinators at each of our centers to find out about the latest classes and wellness opportunites we have or check our monthly menu calendars for new things too!

#### **Charlevoix County Senior Centers Updates**

Octoberfest Celebration is on Friday, October 7, 2022 from 11:30a-1p. Our Halloween Celebration is on Monday, October 31, 2022 from 11:30a-1p.

Wednesday Night dinners are now finished for this year. We will start them back up on Wednesday, May 3, 2023.

Food costs have increased this past fiscal year to between 25% - 35%. The COA has not increased our meal donation request/ price since 2009. It is currently a \$3.00 donation of 60 years old and older and \$6.00 cost for 59 years old and younger. Our meals are becoming Community popular, and we need to really look at what we are charging those not 60 Years old yet to come and participate with our seniors for meals. This is an especially important offering as we all have friends and family, we want to share a meal with that are not our age. That being said, effective October 1, 2022 in the Charlevoix, East Jordan and Boyne Centers we will keep the 60-Year-old and older suggested donations as they are at \$3.00. We will increase our 59 years and younger food charges from \$6.00 to \$8.00.

On Beaver Island, we will keep the Voucher Cost at \$3.00 for 60 Years old and older and the Home Delivered suggested donation at \$3.00. We will increase the Special Meal/Sunday Dinner Cost increased to \$12.00 for 59 Years old and younger. In addition, the Beaver Island Nutritional Contractor Reimbursement to be increased from \$8.95 to \$11.00 for Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner and the Special Meal/Sunday Dinner Reimbursement to be increased from \$10.95 to \$13.00. The Nutritional Contractors had a \$2.00 reimbursement bump back 2019 – 2020 bumping them from \$6.95 to \$8.95 for Breakfast, Lunch and \$8.24 for Dinner/Special Meal/Sunday Dinner Reimbursement to \$10.95.

October 1st we change back to our normal schedules and programing. Wednesday Night Dinners are now over and will not start back up until May 2023.

The Charlevoix County Commission on Aging will also be temporarily taking over the Celebration Ice Cream Socials previous done by the Charlevoix American House due to staffing shortages for these days at the Charlevoix American House.
